NATIONAL

ACTIVITIES

- KWM lawyers and graduates work with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Legal Service QLD (ATSILS) solicitors on preparing and updating radio scripts to deliver CLE to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities (priority communities).
- Tasks may include development of new script narratives, and reviewing script suite for currency and updating as necessary.
- Non-legal staff positions available to review content for accessibility.

OUTPUTS

- Projects for priority communities implemented: CLE provided in partnership with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander-owned radio stations.
- Publication suite maintained, regularly reviewed and updated.
- Culturally appropriate and accessible resources and support provided to ATSILS.

SHORT TERM OBJECTIVES

- Priority communities have improved legal capability and increased knowledge of where to get free, culturally safe, legal help.

LONG TERM OBJECTIVES

- Fewer preventable legal issues experienced by priority communities.
- Priority community members can identify when they have a legal issue, and have the knowledge and confidence to seek appropriate legal help.
- Priority communities have confidence in ATSILS as a credible, reliable and appropriate legal education service.

MEASUREMENT

- Data collection through broadcasters.
- Project review, including any appropriate end client user evaluation, in line with ATSILS reporting processes.
- Bi-yearly impact surveys of:
 - ATSILS staff.
 - KWM participants.

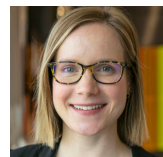
SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS
